

Section V Hockey Sectional Information

The sum of these points, divided by the number of games played equals the Sectional Points number that is used to determine Sectional Playoff Seeding for each team. Overall team records are considered when computing sectional seeding points. Divisional Standings do not have any effect towards a sectional seeding.

Sectional Classes:

Class A (11 Teams): Arcadia/Olympia, Athena/Odyssey, BK/EI/Wayne, Brighton/ER/HFL, Fairport, Gates-Chili, McQuaid Jesuit, Penfield, Pittsford, Rush Henrietta, Schroeder

*The top seeded 5 teams will have a bye in the first round

Class B (12 Teams): Batavia, Brockport, Canandaigua, Churchville-Chili, Geneseo/Livonia, Geneva/Waterloo, Hilton, Irondequoit, Notre Dame of Batavia, Spencerport, Thomas, Victor

*The top seeded 4 teams will have a bye in the first round

Once the regular season is complete, the brackets for Class A and B will be created on Pointstreak.

Sectional Points are awarded as follows:

Win = 5 Points

Loss = 0 Points

Tie = 2.5 Points

OTL = 2.5 Points

Sectional Seeding Tiebreaker Procedure (After seeding points have been computed):

1. Best overall winning percentage (Wins/Total Games)
2. Best record head to head competition between the teams
3. Best record against common sectional opponents (I.E. Starting with the highest seeded teams in Class A to the lowest seeded team in Class B. The advantage goes to the team with the better Win/Loss record against the highest seeded teams.)
4. Coin Toss
